

## STRIKE FORCE FLYBALL RACING CLUB CODE OF ETHICS

**OBJECTIVES:** Training and competing with any dogs shall be done discriminately with emphasis placed on developing good health, sound temperament, willingness to work and other outstanding characteristics of dogs.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:** All Strike Force Flyball Racing Club members shall endeavor to conduct themselves in a manner that will reflect well upon our dogs and our sport. Members shall not malign Strike Force Flyball Racing Club, other competitors, or their dogs. Members agree to promote good sportsmanship and contribute a positive demeanor, both within Strike Force and in the flyball and dog athletics community.

**HEALTH:** All Strike Force Flyball Racing Club members agree to maintain good standards of health and care of their dog(s), including proper veterinary care, adequate quality food and water, and proper socialization.

**MEMBERS SHALL NOT USE ANY MEANS TO DERIVE BETTER RESULTS DURING TRAINING OR COMPETITION THAT ARE ARTIFICIAL AND/OR HARMFUL TO THEIR DOG(S).**

**SAFETY:** All Strike Force Flyball Racing Club members agree to take all available and reasonable measures to ensure the safety of their own dog(s), the team dogs, and any dogs associated with flyball or any other sport.

**ENFORCEMENT:** Upon receipt of written allegations of violations of this Code of Ethics, the Board of Directors will proceed according to the Constitution and Bylaws of Strike Force Flyball Racing Club.
