

## STRIKE FORCE RULES

### Team Guidelines: (10/05):

The Team Goals, Team Structuring, and Team Member Guidelines are included in the Team Guidelines. These Guidelines apply to all dog and handler teams.

### Beginning Team Checklist (11/07):

The Beginning Team Checklist is a tool to determine when a dog moves from Beginner to Intermediate, and then to Advanced. The trainer completes the checklist with input from the box turn trainer.

### Release of Liability (1/07):

Each new member must sign the Release of Liability. The original is mailed to Margaret Smith of Smith Ranch, and a copy is kept in the member's file.

### Number of Dogs in Club (10/17):

The number of dogs in the club shall not exceed 20. If the club is at maximum capacity and an existing member wants to race another of his/her dogs in flyball, that dog will be allowed to join the team.

### Club Hats:

Club hats will be provided to club members the first day of their first tournament as long as supplies last. The official club hat will be a black hat (a Haven Humane hat when available) with the Screaming Eagle logo on it.

### Uniforms:

Red shirt with the yellow team star on the back, that team member's dog in center of star. Tennis ball with Strike Force on the front left. The PetSmart logo on the edge of the right sleeve. If it is a sleeveless shirt, the PetSmart logo should be centered under the star on the back of the shirt. Black pants or shorts.
